The following changes are taking place on the golf course:-

## **FLAG POLES.**

They will be on the greens but **DON'T TOUCH THEM.**

We are lifting cups up so if your ball hits the cup, that'll do.

## **BUGGIES.**

We are wiping down steering wheels, gear selectors and seat handles each evening.

You are advised to do the same, and consider driving alone.

## **BUNKERS.**

Rakes have been removed from all bunkers.

Bunkers remain in play.

All players are advised to bear in mind wider instruction regarding close contact with other people, washing hands wherever possible, etc.

A limited provision for hospitality may be available at the Clubhouse and the Halfway House, and via the hatch onto the patio area (if the Clubhouse is forced to close).

The Pro Shop will remain open in its entirety as long as possible.

If it is forced to close service will be via the window/serverly.
